**Re-Enrollment increases to \$350 if not paid by March 1, 2024

- ECA requests a copy of the ESA contract be sent to the school.
- **Parents/guardians are responsible for the tuition payments until ECA receives a copy of the contract or funds from ESA or a Scholarship Tuition Organization.**
- ECA is affiliated with several Scholarship Tuition Organizations (STOs).
 - STO information is located at ecakingman.org under Admissions/Tuition Assistance.
 - ECA recommends completion of a minimum of three or more STO applications.
- If the full annual tuition amount is paid at time of enrollment a \$250 discount applies.
